Access Health and Community Safe and Inclusive Clubs Project

In 2017-2018 the City of Boroondara led the Inclusive Clubs project, in partnership with Access Health and Community, Leisure Networks (tag all) and WHE. Rolled out across six sporting clubs in Boroondara, the project supported committees in auditing their systems, policies and practices to ultimately develop and implement an inclusion plan. Workshops delivered as part of the project demonstrated how promoting a safe, equal and respectful club culture can attract and retain members from a wide range of backgrounds, experiences and abilities. This project focused particularly on increasing the participation of women on the field, as players, and off the field, in leadership roles, by providing clubs with the tools to build enabling environments, which ultimately benefit all members.

Based on the successes of the Inclusive Clubs project, and the successes of a similar project – the Safe, Respectful and Inclusive Clubs project led by Manningham Council <tag> – Access Health and Community is leading the integration of the two projects.
