March Forum

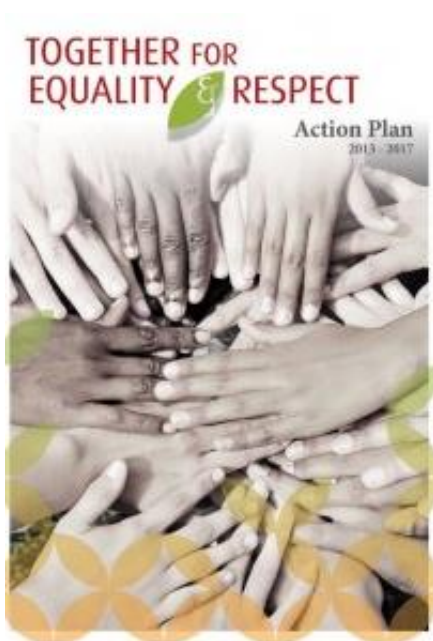
